

Lead researcher discusses the latest Canadian online learning survey

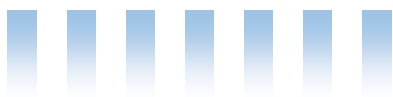
In 2017 a group of independent researchers conducted a survey of all public universities and colleges in Canada to identify the extent of online learning and distance education and to identify policy directions in this area. The survey was repeated in 2018. The survey was conducted in collaboration with the Babson Survey Research group and WCET, who had conducted similar studies in the USA. This presentation will provide a brief summary of the results for both years and an analysis of some of the methodological issues that arose that will be of particular interest to CIRPA members.
