

FUNCTION:

Members-at-large are responsible for activities determined by the Board such as publications, workshops, and other professional development activities. Assignment of other responsibilities shall be determined by the President, in consultation with the members of the Board.

TERM:

Four members-at large are elected to the Executive Committee. Each member-at-large will serve a two-year term and is eligible for re-election, but to no more than two consecutive terms in the same position.

REQUIREMENTS / QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be an active practitioner of institutional research, planning and assessment in a Canadian setting.
- Must commit to attend all annual conferences during their term of office.
- Must commit to attend all mid-term Board meetings during their term of office.
- Prepare for and participate in discussion and deliberations of the Board.
- Have good communication and written skills.
- Have knowledge of, or a willingness to learn, the Constitution, the By-laws and the activities of the Association, and publicly support them.

DUTIES:

- Assist in the development of publications, workshops and other professional development activities that will be of benefit to the CIRPA-ACPRI membership.
- Special projects and other responsibilities as determined by the Board.
